What's been happening with the SPSP MH team



We are pleased to share that the SPSP Mental Health End of Phase Report was published at the end of November.

- October and November have been busy months for the SPSP MH team. We took some time to have a cuppa on World Mental Health day. There has been a lot of travelling to the boards including visits to NHS Shetland and NHS Western Isles.



- The Safety Principle Packages are undergoing further revision following Workstream Development Group meetings and online discussion. Nearly all are available as an online resource.
- Phase 3: the team have been continuing to develop networks and plan for the next phase of SPSP MH.



- We welcomed a group of Danish visitors to Scotland in October, they visited NHS Lanarkshire to learn from their experience of SPSP MH.
- Then in November an Australian colleague visited Scotland to learn more about SPSP MH and the work we are beginning with CAMHS.
- 26th October, Johnathan presented at the Scottish Association of Social Workers Conference, Perth.
- 8th November, Johnathan and John attended the Mental Health Nurses Forum Annual Conference and Awards Ceremony, Forth Valley Royal Hospital.
- 10th November, NHS Highland held an event around the Triangle of Care which Steven and John attended. A report by the Scottish Recovery Network will be issued in due course.
