

## POST-TRAINING COMPETENCY TOOL FOR MANAGERS

**Competency Evaluation:**

**1 = Worker demonstrates or explains to the supervisor a specific skill or information**

- This means they have carried out a skill or explained the principles to an appropriate assessor
- It may mean that there are still some parts of the skill or additional information that they need to know before they are assessed as competent

**2 = Worker demonstrates themselves to be competent**

- This means they have been assessed as competent by an appropriate AHP
- To be assessed as competent the worker must demonstrate that they have knowledge of, and are able to follow, the protocols for the corresponding competency

At each stage the assessor will insert the date and their initials into the box which records the workers level of achievement in the competency being assessed

5. Where appropriate the worker demonstrates when an alternative technique, would be preferable to prescribing equipment				
6. Worker can describe the contra-indications for prescribing an item of equipment				
7. Worker can describe the appropriate indications for providing and using the equipment				
8. Worker demonstrates ability to fit equipment appropriately				
9. Worker demonstrates knowledge of the implications for carers assisting users.				
10. Worker can describe the implications of over-prescription
