

Communication Update – May 18

National Board Collaboration for Transformational Redesign

Background

In order to support **system-wide transformational redesign across health and social care** it has been agreed by The National Board Collaborative that there is a need for a coordinated approach which leverages the unique skills and assets of the National Boards and makes best use of scarce resources.

The National Board Collaboration for Transformational Redesign is being led by Healthcare Improvement Scotland (HIS) and NHS National Services Scotland (NSS) on behalf of all National Boards. All National Boards and other key partners such as the NHS Boards, Integration Authorities, Care Inspectorate, Improvement Service and third and independent sector representatives will have a vital role in informing and shaping this work.

Scope

This project will develop a model of a coordinated offer and approach to system-wide transformational change within health and social care, where the transformation has potential to benefit from national support. This project will not consider a co-ordinated offer and approach to evaluation, which will be dealt with separately.

We will develop a model of an offer which can be accessed by Integration Authorities, NHS Boards, Scottish Government and Regions.

Approach

Throughout the project we will engage with a wide range of collaborators and existing networks to coproduce the offer. We will work in an Agile way enabling value to be created quickly and at every stage.

In order to create successful collaboration, and to work at pace, we will commission independent facilitation and support.

Outputs

The project will:

- Identify and map current offers and capabilities of national organisations providing transformational redesign support.
- Identify current/future customer* needs.
- Conduct a gap analysis between the current offers and the capacity of providers to meet customer needs.
- Identify options to close the gap.

* Customers include Integration Authorities, NHS Boards, Regions and the Scottish Government.

This work is being led by HIS and NSS on behalf of the National Boards and other key partners.
