Professor Brian Dolan



Professor Brian Dolan OBE has a clinical background in emergency care. He is currently Director of Health Service 360 and works in New Zealand, Australia and the UK providing leadership programs, coaching and consulting. He has published over 70 papers and is the author/editor of seven books, mainly on emergency care.

He holds Masters Degrees in Nursing from King's College, London and Educational Research Methodology from Oxford University. He is Honorary Professor of Leadership in Healthcare at the University of Salford, and Visiting Professor of Nursing at the Oxford Institute of Nursing, Midwifery and Allied Health Research.

In 2018 he was voted one of the 20 most influential people in the 70-year history of the UK's National Health Service. In the Queen's 2019 New Years Honours List, Brian was awarded an OBE in the 'For Services to Nursing and Emergency Care'.

Brian has originated a global social movement called #EndPJparalysis to encourage patients to get up, dressed and moving to reduce their risk of deconditioning while in hospital. More information on this can be found here www.endpjparalysis.com
